



## Version 5.0 Update

Welcome to a new generation of Bible study software! The enclosed disk contains a program that will update any version 4 product in THE WORD processor family to version 5.0. For version 5.0 each Bible translation requires about 1 megabyte more of your hard disk space than was required for version 4.

### To update your programs:

Place the Update 5.0 disk in Drive A:  
Enter the command:

**A:UPDATE**

Then follow the instructions displayed.  
The Update program will change:  
all version 4 products, and  
the personal commentary files, and  
the Greek/Hebrew dictionaries.

### \*\*\*\*\* Warning \*\*\*\*\*

**These files will no longer be usable by version 4. So, make certain you have a backup on floppy disk of all version 4 products and all files for your personal commentary and Greek/Hebrew dictionaries.**

Each translation requires the creation of a new Instant Access file. They will be created in the following order: KJVIA, SRNIA, NIVIA, NRNIA, NKJIA, RSVIA. The files for Chain Reference and Chronological Bible are the same for versions 4 and 5.0. The Update program will keep you informed as it replaces your version 4 with the equivalent version 5.0 files. Do not interrupt the program until it has completed. While the update program is running, we encourage you to read the new manual carefully.

### To convert your index files:

The version 4 Verse Indexer product has been replaced by the new version 5 Librarian product. Librarian saves, sorts, merges and deletes Verse List files from your hard disk library. The update disk includes a utility program called CONVERT. This program reads the index files created by Verse Indexer and converts each file to the format required by Librarian. The CONVERT program can be run at any time and as often as you need. The CONVERT program can be used to convert:

any index files you created using Verse Indexer,  
all TOPICS files,  
all PEOPLE files.

If you have a 3.5" Update disk, it includes the CONVERT program. If you have a 5.25" Update disk, the CONVERT program can be found on the separate disk labeled, "Update 5.0 Utilities". Place the disk in drive A: and enter the command:

**A:CONVERT**

You will be asked for the name of the subdirectory where your index files can be found. Then you may choose the subdirectory where the new Librarian files will be stored. Each index will be read and converted to the version 5.0 format. The CONVERT program does not delete the old index files. After you have used the new Librarian files with version 5 and you are satisfied they were converted properly, you may choose to backup the index files to floppy disk and delete them from your hard disk.

Note: If you have a color adaptor card and a monochrome screen, add the /M parameter when executing the UPDATE or CONVERT program. Example: A:UPDATE /M

(Please read the opposite side.)



## Examples of New Features

1. Text is now displayed in an unlimited number of windows that can be moved and sized to divide the screen in the manner best suited to your studies. The number of windows is limited only by the memory of your computer.
2. Full mouse support is available, but not required. If you have a mouse, follow the instructions that came with your mouse for installing the device driver. Usually, this can be done in either of two ways. Include the command `DEVICE=\PATHNAME\MOUSE.SYS` in your `CONFIG.SYS` file. Or include the command `MOUSE.COM` in your `AUTOEXEC.BAT` file.
3. Pull-down menus make all commands available easily. Many function keys have been kept compatible with version 4 where possible.
4. Context sensitive help includes detailed descriptions of every command. Whenever you need assistance just press the F1 key for a description of what to do next.
5. A search request now instantly displays a list of every verse that met your search criteria.
6. The new Librarian product includes a full featured word processor for you to enter your lesson text while you are working with scriptures. Librarian saves, loads, merges and deletes text files from your library of personal studies.

## Many Differences

Version 5.0 is an entirely new program. What you see on the screen and the way you give commands are different from version 4. It is necessary and beneficial for you to read the reference manual to better understand how to take maximum advantage of all features, such as:

1. Personal Commentary is now stored in 1 file for the entire Bible. Therefore, the \* are always displayed indicating a comment is available for the verse.  
(Version 4 kept a separate file for each book.)
2. Range is used only for searching and printing. A window displaying scripture text can always display any verse at any time.
3. Control Options are now set by the Settings Command. (see page 59 of the manual)  
Printer options are set by the Layout command on the File menu.
4. The ASCII utility functions are provided by the File button on the Print command. (see page 31)
5. Version 5.0 of Verse Typist uses the Verse List files from Librarian.  
(Version 4 used the index files from Verse Indexer.)
6. Word Origin analysis is now based on the Verse List last created.  
(Version 4 required a separate search.)

These features and many more are available in the new version 5.0 programs. Please read the manual carefully to take maximum advantage of everything the new programs have to offer.

## New Products

Version 5.0 introduces several additions to THE WORD processor family of products including a new Bible Dictionary. The dictionary defines the special meanings given to words when used in scripture. Common word are not included because their meaning is the same in scripture as when used elsewhere. The Bible Dictionary gives historical background and Biblical usage that helps you understand the language used in scripture. Just select a word from the Bible and the definition of that word as used in the Bible will be displayed. The definitions can be modified and expanded. The HEBREW transliterator is now available for the New International translation. The transliterator is designed to assist the user to better understand the message intended by the original author without becoming an expert in Hebrew. It is designed for anyone with a personal computer and does not require special knowledge of the Hebrew language.
